RESOLUTION NO. 18-23

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH CUSTOM TRUCK & EQUIPMENT FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 2013 INTERNATIONAL MODEL 7400 DIGGER TRUCK AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson's requires a digger type truck to fully service its electric utility lines; and

WHEREAS, there are a limited supply of new and used trucks of the required type available with a new vehicle being priced at \$632,000; and

WHEREAS, the City has located a 2013 truck that is currently available for sale for \$159,500 that will meet all of the requirements for the City's use and a similarly equipped and priced truck cannot be located elsewhere and that and this matter is not amenable to the competitive bidding process as Custom Truck & Equipment is the only known provider; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary that the City acquire a digger vehicle of this size in order to best maintain the City utility service and that this matter is an emergency necessary to preserve the public peace, health, and safety of the City and the emergency condition removes the competitive bidding requirements.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, STATE OF OHIO, as follows:

Section One. The Director of Service and Safety is authorized to enter into an Agreement with Custom Truck & Equipment of Kansas City, Missouri for the purchase of the vehicle described in the exhibit attached hereto and at the terms listed therein for an amount of \$159,500 and any additional costs for its preparation and transport to the City.

Section Two. This Resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency Resolution necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, or safety of the City of Jackson, for the reasons set forth above. Therefore, this Resolution shall go into effect upon passage and approval by the Mayor, as provided in Ohio Revised Code Section 731.30.

Section Three. In the event this Resolution receives a majority vote for passage but fails to receive the required number of votes to pass as an emergency, then this Resolution shall be deemed to have passed but with no emergency clause and shall take effect at the earliest time permitted by law.

Section Four. It is hereby found and determined that all formal actions of this Council relating to the adoption of this Resolution were adopted in an open meeting of this Council, and that the deliberations of this Council that resulted in such formal actions, were in a meeting open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements, including Section 121.22 of the Ohio Revised Code.
