A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF TWO AMKUS BATTERY OPERATED RESCUE TOOLS FROM THE JACKSON FIREFIGHTERS ASSOCIATION FOR USE BY THE JACKSON FIRE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Jackson Firefighters Association has offered to the City of Jackson two Amkus battery operated rescue tools purchased by it at a cost of \$37,811.00 to be used by the Jackson Fire Department; and

WHEREAS, the offered rescue tools will be beneficial to the City and its Fire Department and will serve a municipal purpose; and

WHEREAS, the City of Jackson does agree to accept the donation of the two Amkus battery operated rescue tools and that this matter constitutes an emergency as the ownership of the tools and the ability to take immediate possession and to insure them, is necessary to protect the health, safety and welfare of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT THE LEGISLATIVE AUTHORITY OF THE CITY OF JACKSON, OHIO, HEREBY AUTHORIZES SERVICE-SAFETY DIRECTOR TO EXECUTE THOSE DOCUMENTS NECESSARY TO ACCEPT OWNERSHIP OF THE TWO AMKUS BATTERY OPERATED RESCUE TOOLS AND TO CAUSE IT TO BE LISTED AS PROPERTY OF THE CITY FOR INSURANCE PURPOSES WITH A STATED VALUE OF \$37,811.00 AND TO DECLARE AN EMERGENCY.
